Privacy Policy Template

This privacy policy explains how F&L Kitchens/F&L Supplies LTD ("we", "us", "our") collects, uses, shares, and protects your personal information when you visit our website <u>fandlkitchens.co.uk</u> ("the website"). Please read this privacy policy carefully and contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

What information do we collect?

We collect the following types of personal information from you when you use our website:

- Contact information, such as your name, email, address, and phone number, when you request a quote, contact us, or subscribe to our newsletter.
- Technical information, such as your IP address, browser type, device type, operating system, and other information about your use of our website, when you access our website.

How do we collect this information?

Who do we share this information with?

We share this information with the following parties:

 delivery companies, marketing agencies, etc. We only share the information
 that is necessary for them to perform their functions and we require them to
 protect your information and comply with applicable laws.
- Other third parties, such as law enforcement, regulators, courts, or other
 parties, when we are required or permitted by law to do so, or when we need
 to protect our rights and interests, or the rights and interests of others.

Do we sell or transfer this information to anyone?

We do not sell or transfer your personal information to anyone, except in the following cases:

- For business purposes, such as in the event of a merger, acquisition, reorganization, sale of assets, or bankruptcy, we may transfer your information to the relevant parties involved, subject to their compliance with applicable laws and this privacy policy.
- For legal purposes, such as in response to a valid legal request, court order, or subpoena, we may disclose your information to the relevant authorities or parties, as required or permitted by law.

How do we protect this information?

We take appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. These measures include:

- Using encryption, security protocols, and firewalls to protect your information during transmission and storage.
- Limiting the access to your information to our authorized employees, agents, or service providers, who need to know it for their functions and who are bound by confidentiality obligations.

- The right to complain to a supervisory authority, such as to lodge a complaint with the relevant data protection authority in your jurisdiction, if you are

unhappy with how we handle your information or with the exercise of your rights.
